just sum of one hundred & fifty dollars for the use of the
Commonwealth to which payment well & truly to be
made we bind ourselves our heirs Executors & Assigns by
these presents sealed with our seals & dated this 10th day of
February — 1802

The condition of the above obligation is such
that whereas there is a marriage intended to be solemnized
between the above bound Charles Wade and
Polly Nichols ——— of this County Now if
there be no lawful cause to obstruct the said marriage
then this obligation to be void or else to remain in
full force & Virtue.
