PARKS, ROBERT (2), s. of Edward (1), and Dorothy, was b. 12 Sept. 1707; had a cattle mark recorded for him on 16 Oct. 1724; on 2 June 1741 was conv. 100 a. Come By Chance, by William Jarman and w. Sarah; conv. prop. to his s. Laban on 21 Jan. 1763; had iss.: LABAN, alive in 1763; (poss.) ROBERT, Jr., m. Mary Fuller on 19 Nov. 1761 (69:297; 75:507; 131).

PARKS, PHILIP (3), poss. s. of Edward (1), was b. 29 Dec. 1712 (but parents not named); m. Hannah Packow on 22 Dec. 1746; 131).

PARKS, JOHN (4), poss. son of Edward (1), m. Bridget Milhughes on 13 Sept. 1743 or 29 Oct. 1743, and may be the John who m. 2nd Sarah Linchfield on 10 Sept. 1748; in 1750 owned 50 a. Ebenezer's Park, 310 a. The Range, and 319 a. The Forest; Parks 1st w. was the wid. of Bartholomew Milhouse, whose est. they admin. on 21 July 1744 (3:361; 73:297; 126:223; 131; 133:161; 153:32).

PARKS, WILLIAM (5), poss. s. of Edward (1), may have been b. c.1714; in 1754 purch. 50 a. Turkey Cock Alley from Thomas Cockey Deye, and in 1761 was conv. 19 a. Chenoweth's Adventure by Richard Chenoweth (82:220; 85:342; Parks Notes, at the Maryland Historical Society).

PARKS, RICHARD (or NICHOLAS), was in Balto. Co. by 1701 as a taxable in s. side Patapsco Hund. (143).

PARLETT, MARTIN, m. Mary (prob. dau. of Henry Fitch), on 16 April 1723 in P. G. Co., when he m. Mary Burrows; was in Balto. Co. by 20 Jan. 1728 when he wit. the will of Thomas Reviss of Balto. Co.; on 3 Feb. 1734 Henry Fitch of Balto. Co., for love he bore his dau. Mary Parlett conv. her 200 a., one-half of Chance; iss.: MARY, b. 6 June 1727; ELIZABETH, b. 13 Sept. 1731 (74:166; 125:92; 133:12, 26; 263).

PARLETT, WILLIAM, was in Balto. Co. by 1748 and d. there in 1780; m. by 14 Oct. 1751 Sarah, dau. of Charles Gorsuch; in 1750 owned 50 a. Parlett's Fancy and other land; d. leaving a will proved 15 Aug. 1780; had iss.: CHARLES; JOSHUA; DAVID; WILLIAM; POLL, m. (---) Martin; MARY, b. 12 June 1748, m. Nicholas Grimes; SARAH, b. 12 May 1750, m. Thomas Roberts(on); RACHEL (5:197; 10:256; 112:411; 133:89; 153:62).

THE PARRISH FAMILY is the subject of Scott Lee Boyd's The Parrish Family (Santa Barbara: 1935).

PARRISH, EDWARD (1), progenitor, was b. c.1640, and d. c.1680 at West R., A. A. Co.; m. c.1664 Clara (---); was transp. into Md. in 1655 by William Piper; surv. many tracts incl. 2000 a. of Parrish's Range and 150 a. Parrish's Choice; d. by 17 April 1680 when Clara Parrish ren. right to admin. in favor of Col. Thomas Taylor; had iss.: EDWARD, b. c.1669/70; JOHN, b. c.1672; ANN, b. c.1674, m. Matthew Hawkins; MARY, b. c.1676, m. as 2nd w. Matthew Hawkins; WILLIAM, b. c.1678, d. c.1771/2 (206-7A:66; 209-12:35; 211; 386; Boyd).

PARRISH, EDWARD (2), s. of Edward (1), was b. c.1669/70, and d. c.1723 in A. A. Co.; m. Mary Roberts, dau. of Andrew and Mary Roberts; she m. 2nd, on 16 March 1735, Stephen Warman; he gave his age as c.48 in Nov. 1718; d. leaving a will, May 1722/3 - 14 June 1723; will of Mary Roberts Parrish Warman was made 5 April 1750; had iss.: SARAH, b. c.1691, m. Thomas Norris in 1708; ELIZABETH, b. c.1693, m. Jacob Duhadaway in 7 mo., 1712; EDWARD, b. c.1693, m. Rachel Harwood on 10 Dec. 1722 at Tred Haven Meeting; JOHN, b. c.1698, m. Elizabeth Roberts, in 11 mo., 1722; ANN, b.

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1702, d. 1776, m. 1st William Puntany and 2nd Mayberry Helms; MARY, b. 1704, m. Samuel McCubbin in 1727; and WILLIAM, b. Jan. 1713, d. 1731 unm. (Boyd).

PARRISE, JOHN (3), s. of Edward (1) and Clara, was b. c.1672, m. 3 d, 11 mo., 1700/1, Sarah Franklin, wid. of William Horne, and dau. of Robert and Sarah (Gott) Franklin; John d. by 16 June 1725 when Sarah Parrish posted admin. bond, with John Parrish; est. was admin. 9 Aug. 1727 and 24 May 1731 by Sarah, who said that the dec. left 9 ch.; in Aug. 1728 his orphans under age were Clare, Susanna, and Richard; had iss.: WILLIAM, b. c.1701/2, d. 1728; JOHN, Jr., b. c.1703/4; EDWARD, b. c.1705/6; ELIZABETH, m. James Bosley on 26 Nov. 1730; SARAH, m. Anthony Arnold; ART-RIDGE, m. "out of meeting in 1730;" CLARE; SUSANNA; RICHARD, m. Rachel Owens and lived to be 104 years, in Monongalia Co. (now W.) Va. (3:70, 95; 12:453; 28:27; 30:10; Boyd).

PARRISH, WILLIAM (4), s. of Edward (1) and Clara. was b. c. 1678 in A. A. Co., d. c.1771 in Balto. Co.; m. Susannah (---) and had iss.: EDWARD; WILLIAM; JOHN, b. 30 June 1723, m. Mary Price on 30 March 1744; SUSANNA, m. Aquila Carr on 26 d, 2 mo., 1745; MARY; and JOSEPH (Boyd).

PARRISH, JOHN (5), s. of Edward (2), was b. c.1698, d. Oct. 1745; m. Elizabeth Roberts in 11 mo., 1722; admin. bond was posted 4 June 1746 by Elizabeth Parrish with Alexander Lawson and Richard Croxall; est. was admin. by Elizabeth Parrish on 5 Sept. 1747 and by Joseph Taylor, exec. of Eliz. Parrish, on 26 April 1750; dec. left iss.: ROBERT, b. 12 Oct. 1727; JOHN, b. 20 Jan. 1729; EDWARD, b. 12 Feb. 1731; ISAAC, b. 9 Oct. 1735; MARY, b. 8 Aug. 1738; ELIZABETH, b. 16 Oct. 1740; ANN, b. 10 Jan. 1745 (4:184; 5:120; 12:477; 136; Boyd).

PARRISE, JOHN (6), s. of John (3), was b. c.1703/4, d. c.1785; m. 1st Catherine (---), and 2nd, on 2 Jan. 1733 in St. Paul's Par., Elizabeth Thomas; as John Parrish, Jr., in 1750 owned 100 a. part Parrish's Forest; had iss.: JOHN; WILLIAM; JONATHAN; RICHARD, d. 1820, m. 1776 Sarah Baker; CLARA; ELIZABETH; ANNE; RACHEL; SARAH; and MARY (133:151; 153:49; Boyd).

PARRISH, EDWARD (7), s. of John (3), was b. c.1705/6, d. testate in Balto. Co.; m. Elizabeth, dau. of Stephen and Elizabeth (Hubbard) Gill. on 3 May 1735 in St. Paul's Par.; in 1750 owned 100 a. Parrish's Forest; d. leaving a will, 26 May 1773 - 26 July 1773; had iss.: RICHARD; EDWARD, m. Prudence (---); STEPHEN, m. Margaret (---); WILLIAM; JOHN; BENJAMIN; JAMES: SARAH; ELIZABETH; ARTRIDGE; and SUSAN (112:240; 153:49; Boyd).

PARRISH, RICHARD (8), s. of John (3), was under age in Aug. 1728; m. Rachel Owen; in 1750 owned 50 a. Bachelor's Fancy; moved to Fayette Co., Penna.; had iss. (28:27; 153:57; Boyd).

PARRISH, RICHARD (9), s. of William (4), was b. c.1719, d. 5 d, 7 mo., 1788 in his 70th yr; m. on 5 Feb. 1742/3 Keturah Price, b. c.1720, d. 22 d, 2 mo., 1789: may be the William who in 1750 owned 250 a. part Roberts Forest in 1757 was appointed an elder of Gunpowder Meeting; had iss.: WILLIAM, b. 5 April 1744; MARY, b. 26 Dec. 1746, m. Samuel Price; SUSANNA, b. 3 June 1749, d. 24 Jan. 1820; KETURAH, b. 23 Oct. 1753 (136; 153:8; Boyd).

JOEN (1), s. of William (4), was b. 30 June 1723, d. 2 Aug. 1796, m. on 30 March 1744 at Gunpowder Meeting, Mary Price, b. 20 March 1726, d. 31 d, 8 mo., 1793, dau. of John Price; his home was the site of an indulged meeting, 1760; he later became lame in both legs and a committee of Friends was appointed to collect £ 10 to pay his doctor; had iss.: HANNAH, b. 5 July

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July 1748; MORDECAI, b. 3 Feb. 1750; ANN MARIA, b. 3 June 1753; MORDECAI, b. 3 Feb. 1755, m. Rachel Malone; AQUILA, b. 15 Aug. 1737 (136; Boyd).

PARRISH, JOSEPH (11), s. of William (4), in 1755 reported himself as having married "out of meeting;" was later disowned for fighting in 1759 (136).

PARRISH, (---), m. by 8 May 1751, (---), dau. of John Harryman (5:199).

PARRISH, (---), m. by 16 Jan. 1754, Ketura, dau. of Samuel Merryman (111:55).

PARRISH, ALEXANDER, m. Jane Chatto on 1 Feb. 1737 (128:95).

PARRISH, EDWARD, m. by 30 May 1751 a dau. of John Harryman, and in 1750 owned 592 a. Parrish's Range (153:94; 201-30:78).

PARRISH, WILLIAM, d. by 10 March 1728 when admin. bond was posted by John Parrish, exec., with William and Edward Parrish (12:457).

PARSLEY, ISRAEL, m. Sarah Cheyrton on 5 Feb. 1743 (131).

PARSONS, ANN, was ind. for bast. in June 1738 (31:221).

PARSONS, MARY, was tried for bast. in Aug. 1738 (31:274).

PARSON, SIMEON. See PEARSON, SIMON.

PARSONS, THOMAS, came into the country last Christmas with Capt. James Bustell; was sold to Amos Fogg and then to Edward Day; pet. for his freedom in Nov. 1759 (46:237).

PARTRIDGE, Dr. BUCKLER (1), was in Balto. Co. by Nov. 1718 when the court ordered that he be given a certificate showing he was a freeholder and res. of the county; may be the Buckler Partridge, merch. of Bristol, who purch. 165 a. Partridge Chance (formerly called Thomas Adventure) from Thomas and Sarah Matthews; in June 1735 purch. Partridge's Forest, formerly part of Selsed, from John Boring; in Sept. 1740 purch. part Balleston from John and Eleanor Long; d. by 4 Aug. 1742 when admin. bond was posted by Jane Partridge with Thomas Sligh and Henry Morgan; est. was admin. 5 June 1747, 24 Oct. 1750, and 8 Sept. 1760; in Dec. 1749 Samuel Smith conv. 57 a. Richardson's Neglect to Jane Partridge; in 1750 Jane owned 55 a. Thomas' Adventure, 26 a. part Good Luck, 25 a. Thomas' Range, and 34 a. Richardson's Neglect; Jane d. leaving a will, 6 Sept. 1758 - 3 Nov. 1761, naming ch. William, Daubeny Buckler, Ann w. of Joshua Bond, Frances w. of Jacob Bond, and Elizabeth w. of Heigh Sollers; admin. bond on her est. was posted 7 Feb. 1763 by William Partridge with Joshua Bond; Buckler and Jane had iss.: WILLIAM, prob. d. after 1763 unnm.; DAUBENY BUCKLER; ANN, m. Joshua Bond; FRANCES m. Jacob Bond on 28 Dec. 1747; ELIZABETH, m. Heighe Sollers; and FLURRE, b. 24 March 1736 (4:152, 325; 6:6, 161; 7:195; 12:469, 484; 23:38; 70:208; 74:221; 75:449; 111:339; 134:47; 153:81).

PARTRIDGE, DAUBENY BUCKLER (2), s. of Dr. Buckler (1), d. c. 1769 in Balto. Co.; m. Ann (prob. dau. of Sabrett Sollers); gave his age as 45 in 1767; in 1750 owned 2/3 Thomas Adventure, 175½ a. part Good Luck, and 50 a. Thomas Range; d. leaving a will, 2 April. 1767 - 10 Nov. 1769, named w. Anne, and these ch.: WILLIAM; DAUBENY BUCKLER; and JOHN (112:119; 153:81; 210-30:860; 310).
